An **amphibian** is a cold-blooded animal with a backbone and permeable skin that lays eggs without a shell.

A <u>cold-blooded</u> animal relies on the surrounding temperature for their body temperature. A more scientific word is <u>ectothermic</u>, which translates to "outside temperature."

Question 1:

Can you name some animals that are members of the amphibian family?

Frogs, toads, and salamanders are all types of amphibians. Fun fact: Caecilians are an interesting, worm-looking amphibian found burrowed underground.

Question 2:

Draw the life cycle of a frog with as much detail as you can.
