**Some animals have external ears and some do not. Describe the ear of a lizard and how it hears sound.**

A lizard does not have an external or outer ear like a human or an elephant. A lizard's ear is an internal structure inside of its head. There is a hole beside or behind the eyes, on the sides of the face that funnel sound into the structure to hear.

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**Find different items around your home that you think would make different sounds or frequencies. Which items make high pitched sounds? Which items make low pitched sounds? Why do you think these items sound the way they do?**
